**Hours:** Daycamps operate from 8:00am-5:00pm, with structured programming provided from 9:00am to 4:00pm.

**Fee:** The camps cost \$100 per week/ per child for City Residents and LSD community /partners) and \$120 for others. Except for weeks 1 & 6 which are only 4 days long and cost \$80 for City Residents and LSD and community partners and \$96 for non-city residents. Daycamps are also available by the day for a fee of \$25 for City Residents and LSD community /partners and \$30 for all others.
