Understanding the Lanes

The DIAMOND in the lane means that the lane is reserved for BICYCLES ONLY. Vehicle parking is not permitted.



No DIAMOND in the lane means that vehicle parking is permitted. Cyclists should expect parked cars.



Cyclists should use designated bike lanes instead of sidewalks

Wear A Helmet

There are fines in both the City By-Laws and under the Motor Vehicle Act that are associated with not wearing a helmet. Fines vary and can be charged to the parent if the bicyclist is under 16.



Did You Know?

Every person riding a bicycle upon a roadway must adhere to all the same rules that apply to motorists. In addition...

- Cycling reduces our carbon footprint
- It is a great form of exercise
- It can help reduce traffic congestion

There is also a City By-Law fine for riding your bicycle on a sidewalk

By obeying these simple rules not only will it make your ride safer and more pleasurable, but it will ensure our pedestrians will be safer on our sidewalks.



Under the Motor Vehicle Act...

- You must have a bell, horn or some type of signalling device.
- You must wear a helmet.
- If operating a bicycle at night you must have some type of a headlight and a red rear reflector.
- Every person operating a bicycle upon a roadway shall ride as near to the right side of the roadway as practicable.
