

## Nashwaaksis Fieldhouse General User Rules and Facility Regulations

### User Rules:

- Members must show their membership card at every visit.
- Smoking, swearing, fighting, abuses of equipment or other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- Vehicles parked in no parking spaces/zones will be towed.
- Parents / guardians must supervise their children (under age 12) at all times.
- Field House staff will allocate court space.
- Indoor footwear is recommended, outdoor shoes are damaging to the floor surface as well as making the floor slippery and dirty.
- Food or drink are not permitted in the activity areas
- The mezzanine is for booked group use only.
- Equipment sign out privileges are extended to members only.
- We are not responsible for items lost or stolen. Please make use of lockers and bring your own lock. Locks can not be left on overnight.
- Users/members participate at their own risk.

### Facility Regulations:

- All footwear worn outdoors must be removed upon entering.
- Participants must follow the direction of Recreation. Division supervisors.
- Areas/equipment not needed by your group will remain locked. If you need access to these areas, the Recreation. Division supervisor will open them up. Recreation Division supervisors will distribute equipment.
- Ensure that a group leader is present and responsible for the supervision of program participants and spectators.
- There will be NO FOOD OR DRINK permitted in the gyms.
- You are responsible for your own set-up and take-down of equipment.
- You should bring a game ball of your own if you wish to have a quality ball. Our equipment is used every day and may not meet your standards.
- We are not responsible for lost/stolen equipment or personal items.
- Groups must accept full responsibility for any damages or loss of equipment.
- If Recreation Division supervisors need to stay beyond their normal supervisory hours to clean-up after your group, you will be billed for the additional time.
