SPORTS FIELDS INFORMATION

USER GUIDELINES FOR SPORT FIELDS

1. Weekend maintenance will not be carried out before the Victoria Day weekend. Weather permitting, all playing fields officially open and regular maintenance begins Tuesday May 22, 2007.
2. FIELD PAYMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE YOUR FIRST GAME OF THE SEASON ALONG WITH PLAYER LIST INCLUDING NAMES, PHONE NUMBERS AND ADDRESSES WITH POSTAL CODE.
3. Consuming alcohol on or around city fields is prohibited. Violators risk losing future access to all city sports fields.
4. Regular season play begins (weather permitting) May 22 and ends Sept 30, 2007. All games including playoffs must be completed by and no later than Sept. 30, 2007
5. Credits for rainouts or cancellations will be honoured. For cancellations made by seasonal user groups, we require 24 hours notice.
6. PLEASE NOTE: Weekend request for field bookings received after 5:00pm on the Thursday prior cannot be guaranteed. Staff will try to accommodate the request but there is no guarantee.
7. ONLY RECREATION VEHICLES AND AUTHORIZED MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEES ARE PERMITTED TO DRAG OR WORK ON FIELDS.
8. Motorized vehicles of any description are not permitted in city parks (By-law No. L-8)
9. We request your assistance in keeping the sports fields clean and instruct all to use our garbage receptacles.
10. No teams are to practice on sports fields without booking through the Recreation Division.
11. Tampering with lighting or other city-owned equipment is prohibited.
12. Any group misusing the fields, causing public disturbance or harassing city maintenance staff will be suspended from any further play on city facilities and all fees will be forfeited.
13. During any tournament play field maintenance crews must be given clear access to fields to carry out their duties. Players must leave the playing area. Failure to do so could mean loss of field privileges.
14. In the event of inclement weather please call the Sports Field Hot Line at 460-2881 to confirm field conditions and to note any field closures.

FIELD FEE INFORMATION

Minor Groups – All youth registered in a minor sport pay a Field Maintenance Fee to maintain and upkeep the City of Fredericton Sports Fields. Fees are due upon registration with the associations.

City Resident 6 and under – Field Fee – \$11.40 (hst included)

Non Resident 6 and under – Field Fee – \$22.80 (hst included)

City Resident 7 and over – Field Fee - \$17.10 (hst included)

Non Resident 7 and over – Field Fee - \$34.20 (hst included)

Adult Groups – All seasonal leagues groups must supply a team(s) roster complete with names, addresses, phone numbers and postal codes. All non City of Fredericton Residents must pay a Field Maintenance Fee of \$17.10 per player for the upkeep of city fields. Game rates are based on field used and if lights are required (see list) Ball field games are 2 hours in length and Soccer/playing fields are 1.5 hours in length.

***Royals Field** - \$22.80 per game or practice. Lights are 57.00 extra. Single games must start no later than 8:00pm and Double-Headers no later than 6:00pm. Practices under the lights must cease by 11:00pm

Tournament Fees (hst included) The total tournament fee due must be paid in full by the WEDNESDAY OF THE WEEK PRIOR TO THE EVENT. The tournament schedule must also be submitted two weeks prior to the tournament. When scheduling tournaments that incorporate more than one field, please stagger start times to allow field crews time to travel to all necessary fields.

CLASS A These facilities are our primary ball diamonds for servicing. They are of Proper dimensions and are fenced. The fields are maintained daily depending upon use and weather conditions.

CLASS B These facilities are standard dimension fields. They are fenced in and receive maintenance on a regular basis.

CLASS C These are standard facilities with multi-purpose use and are used for recreational non-competitive leagues. Maintenance is done on a scheduled basis.
