PROVINCIAL HERITAGE PERMIT

In accordance with the provisions of the *Heritage Conservation Act*, the City of Fredericton has given notice to the Minister that it intends to carry out the following activity at the New Brunswick's 104th Regiment of Foot Provincial Heritage Place, in Fredericton, New Brunswick.

- The temporary removal of the monument and its re-instatement at the new Queen Street entrance to Officers' Square.

This activity is approved based on the plans and specifications submitted for the project.

Any work beyond the scope outlined above will require a subsequent Heritage Permit, subject to review and approval of adequate final drawings and specifications.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the permit may result in the revocation of the permit or an order to:

- Cease the work;
- Remove the contravention; or
- Restore the land, building or structure to the condition it was in immediately prior to the activity being carried out.

It is the applicant's responsibility to consult with Archaeological Services to ensure the work has the necessary archaeological monitoring and/or permits.

This permit is valid until: December 31, 2021
