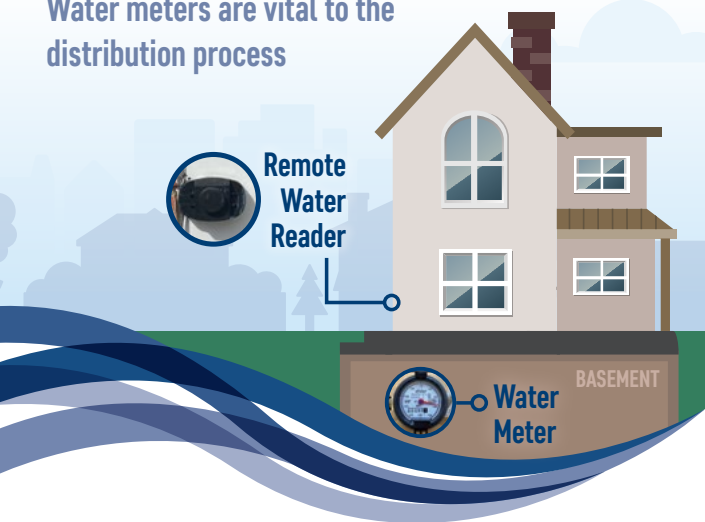


DELIVERING Safe Drinking Water to Your Home

Water meters are vital to the
distribution process



The water meter, found inside your property, records the volume of water used. A water meter remote, installed inside or outside of your property, allows the Utility to obtain meter readings for water usage without entering your home.

Water meters encourage water conservation, allows the Utility to detect leaks inside your property and provides data for billing purposes.

Our new water meter remotes use radio frequencies to transmit information to Utility staff as they travel through neighbourhoods, improving staff efficiency and controlling Utility costs.

Approximately 18,500 water meters can be found in Fredericton homes and businesses. The City's Water Utility works to replace up to 1,000 of these each year. In-person COVID restrictions, and related supply chain issues, have put us behind.

If your water meter is 18+ years old, Utility staff will be leaving notices at your property or messages on your phone. Help keep Fredericton's Water Utility running efficiently by working to replace aging water meters.
