



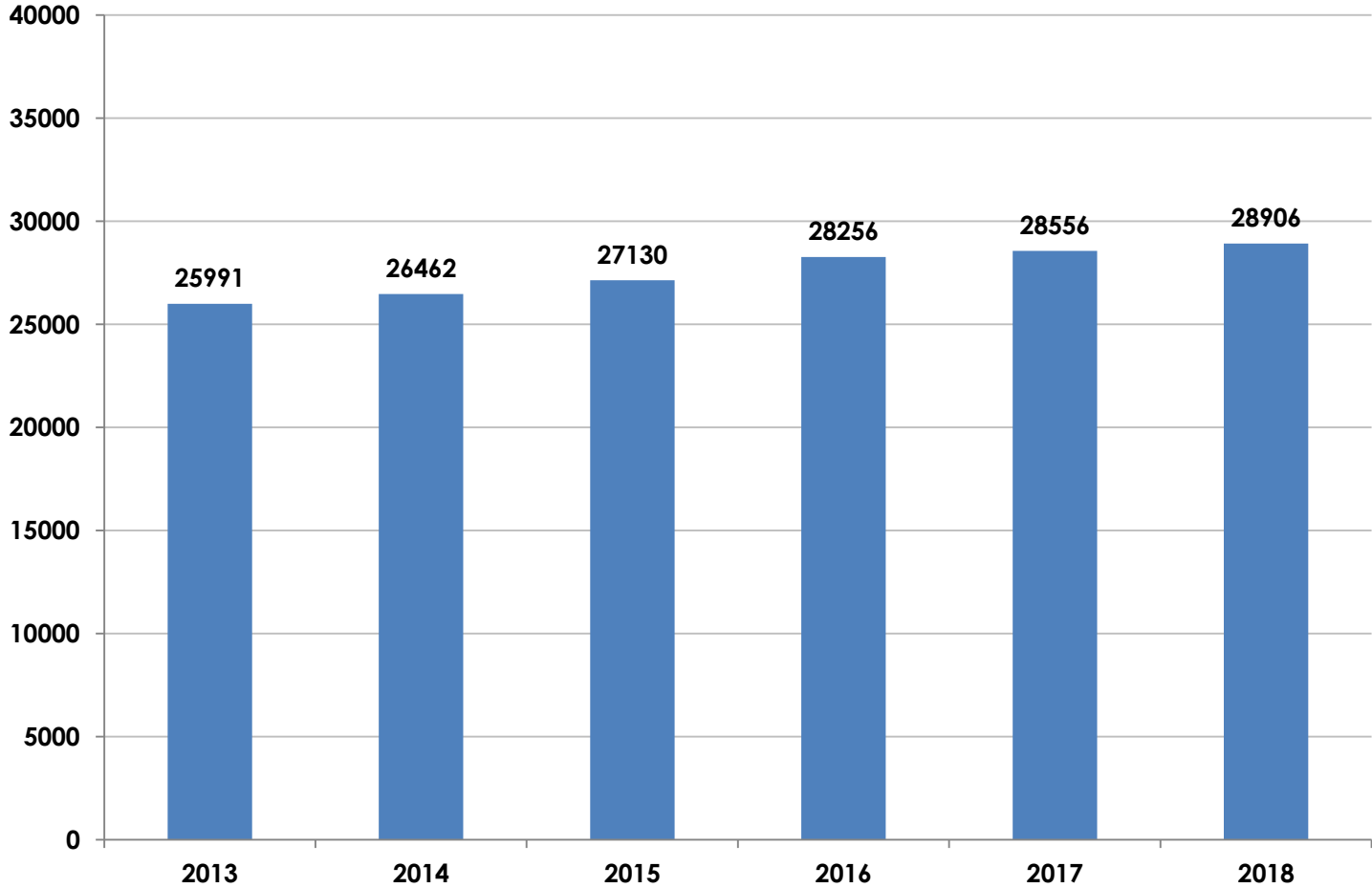

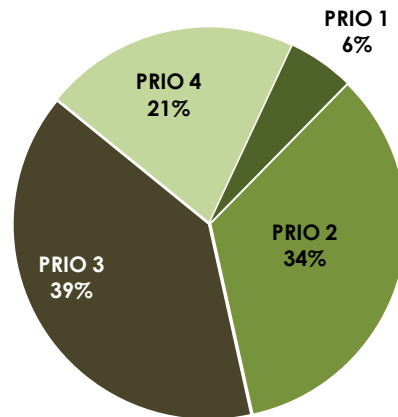

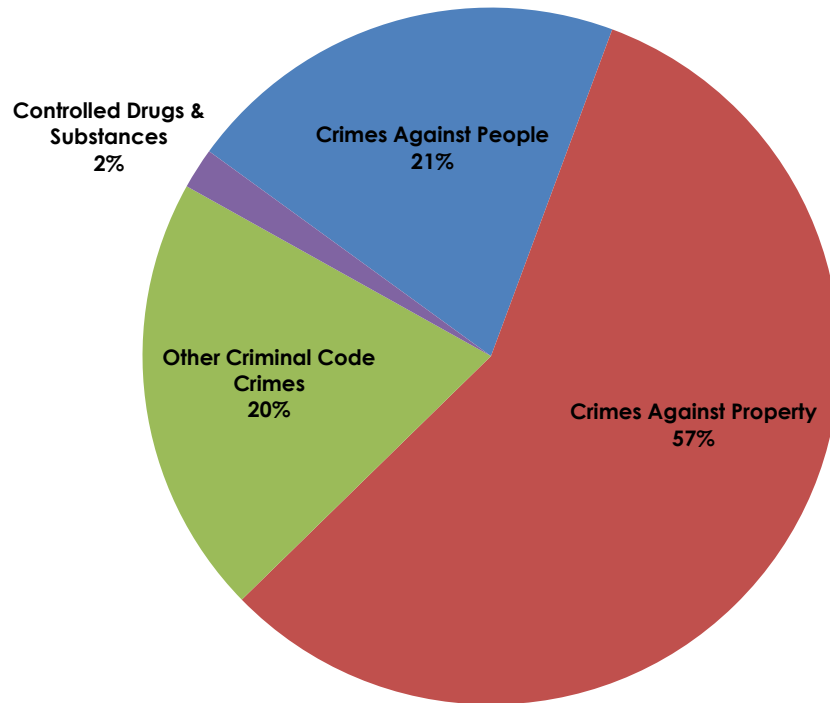
## CALLS FOR SERVICE BY PRIORITY



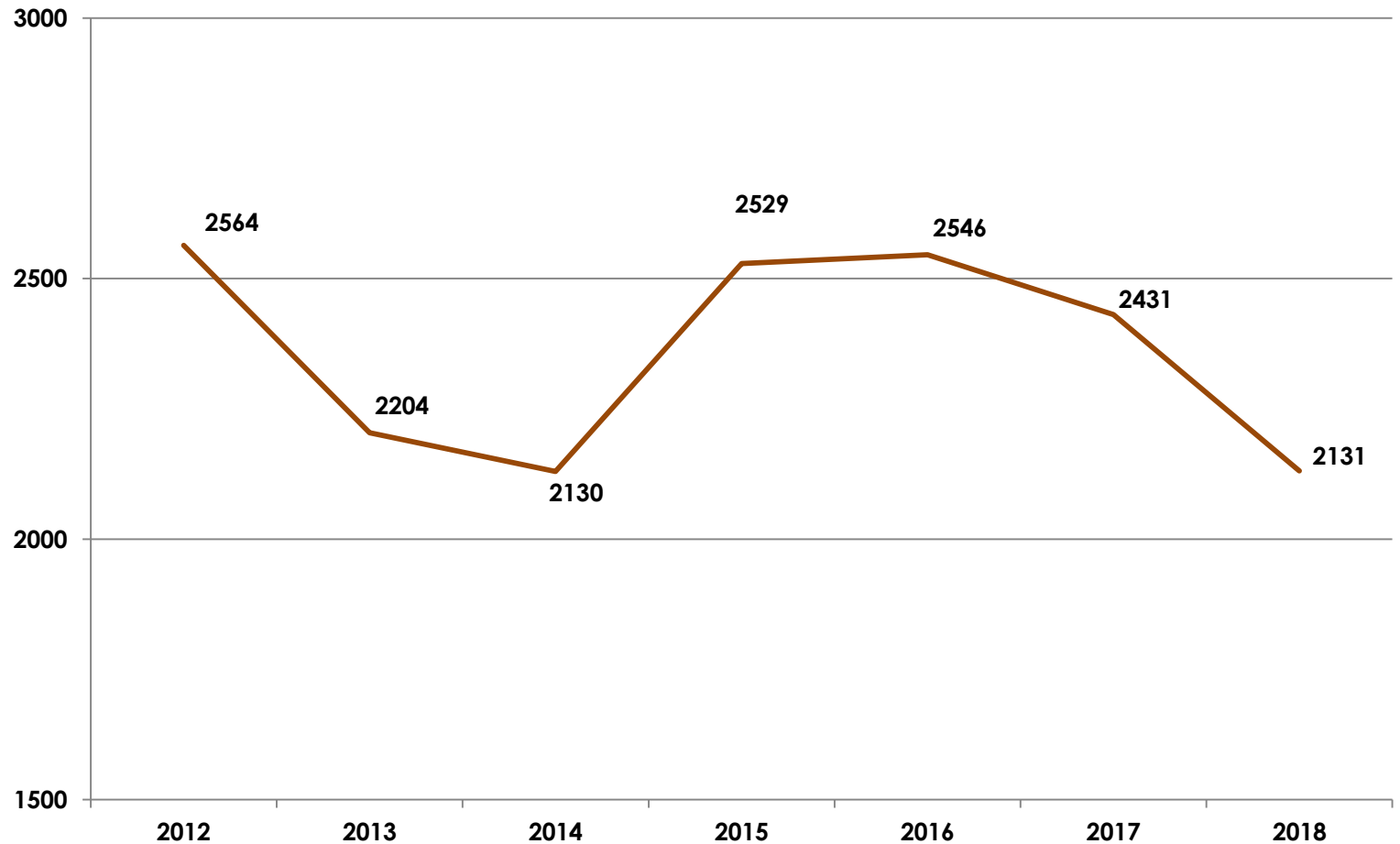
- The priority level dictates the urgency and the response

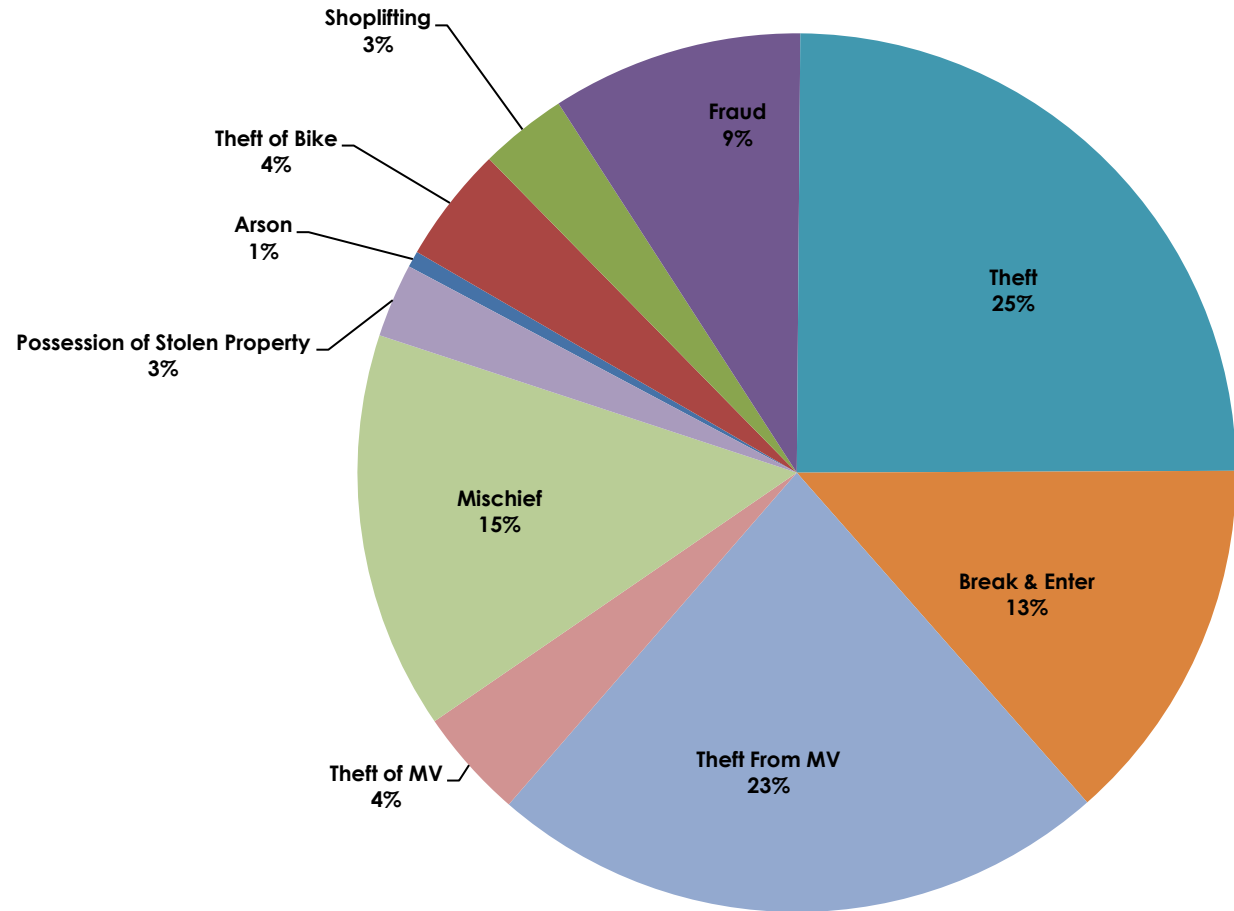
## 2018 TOTAL CRIMINAL CODE/CDSA OFFENCES



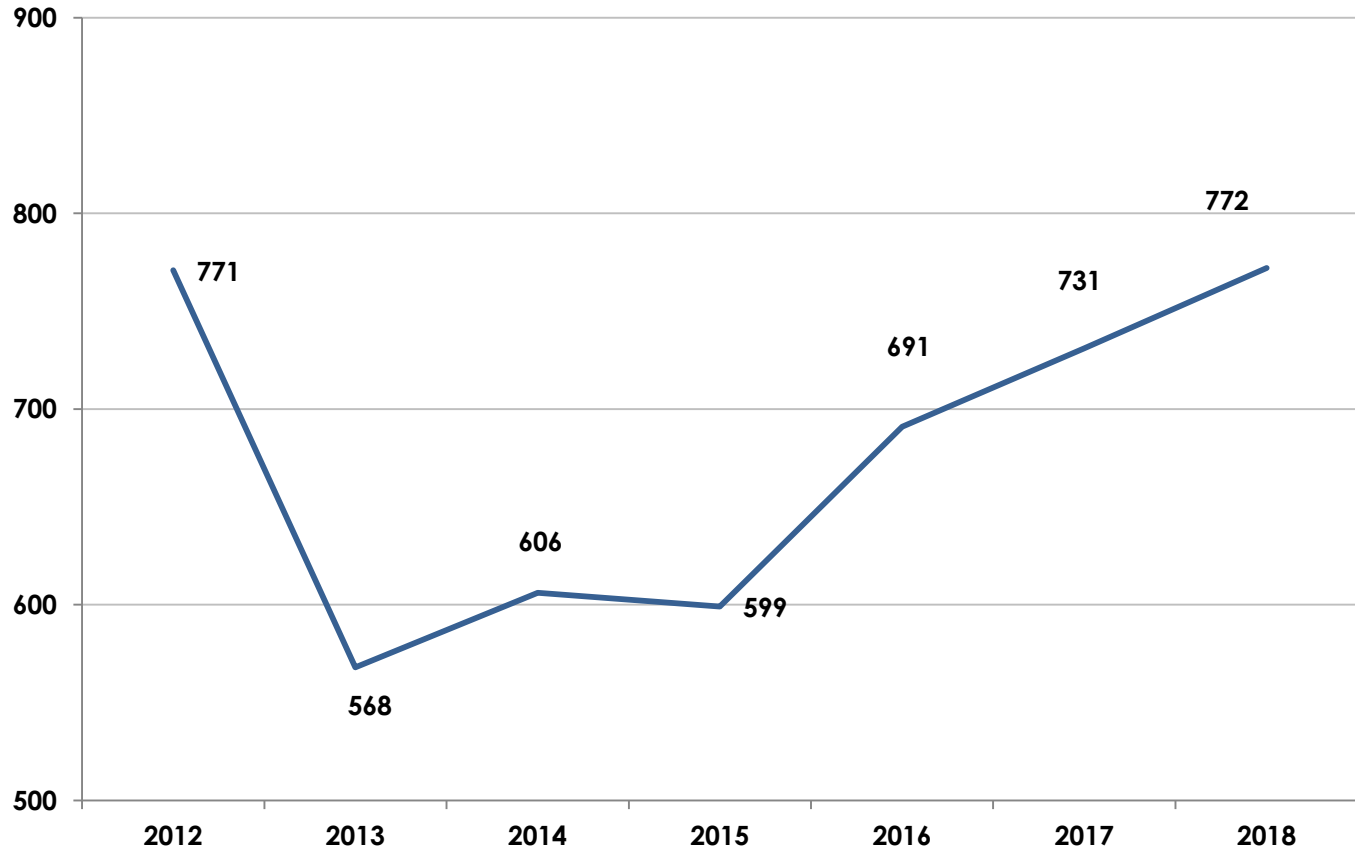

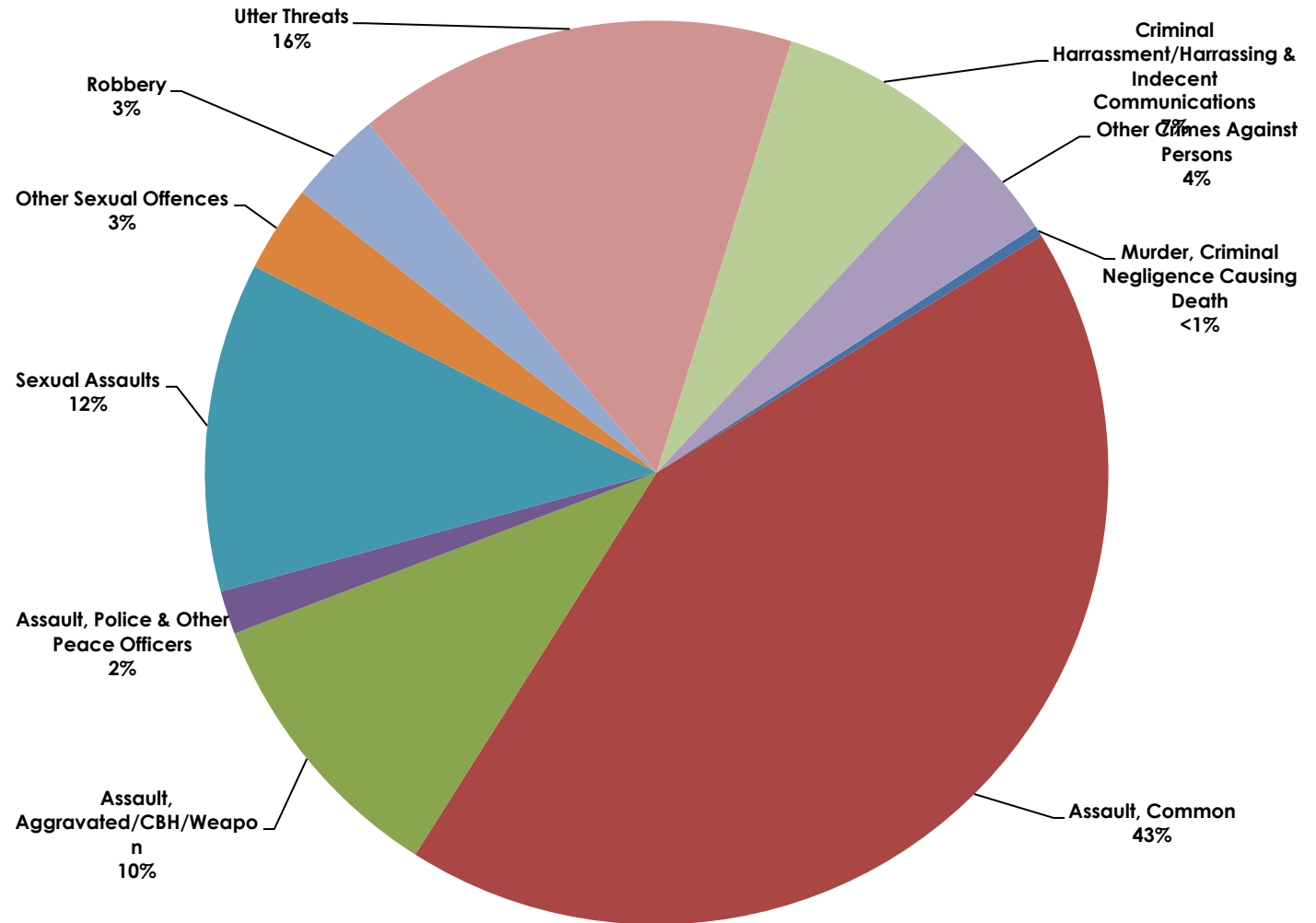

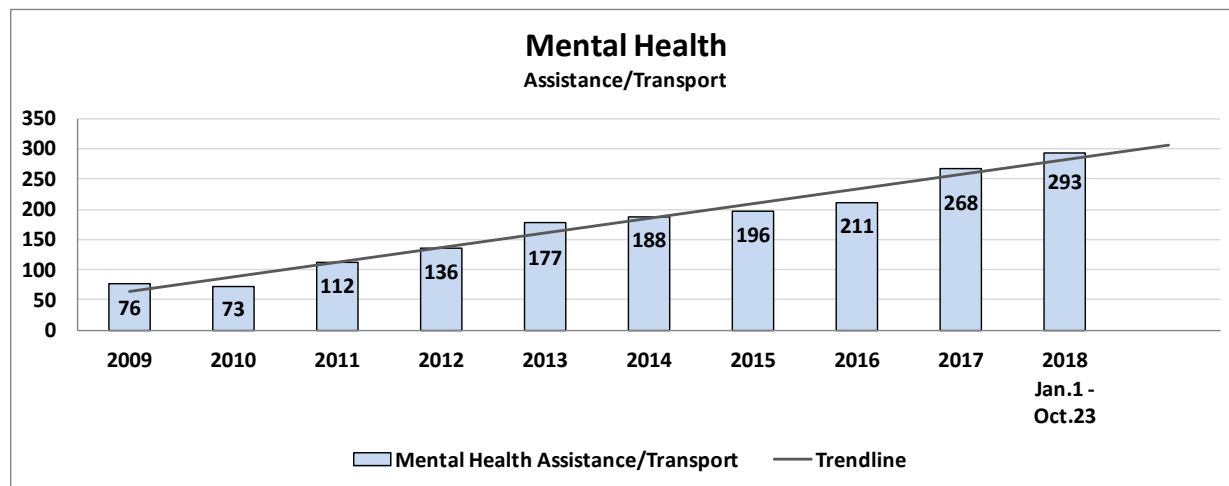

# Mental Health/Addictions Calls for Service

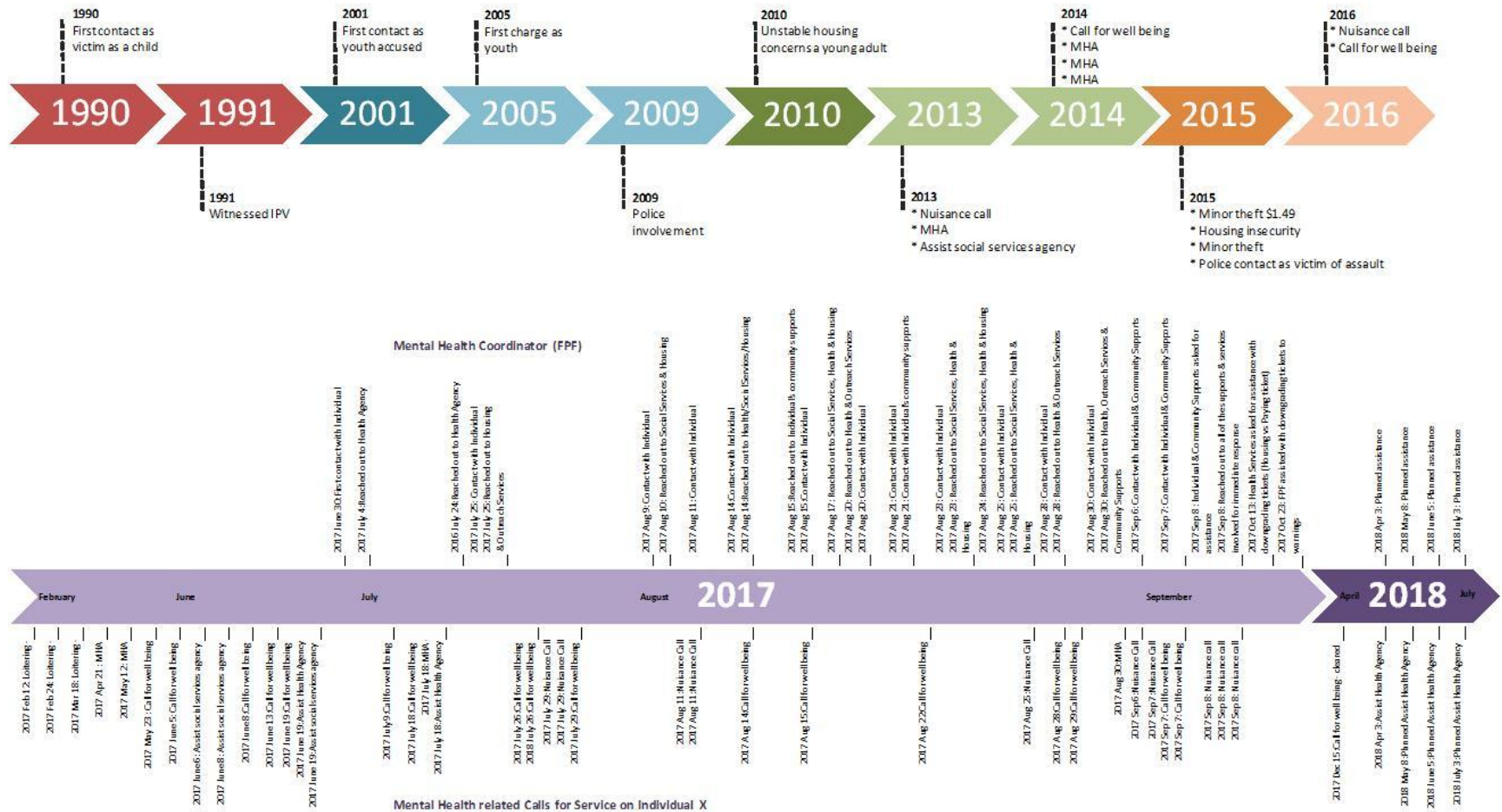
- Calls relating to mental health/addictions are rising
- Mental health issues are often downloaded to the police
- Waiting times for officers in the emergency room are high every time a person is taken to the hospital for crisis mental health
  - $\approx$  3 hours per hospital visit
- Fredericton Police Youth at Risk and Mental Health Coordinator
- MOU with Mobile Mental Crisis Unit
- Ongoing work with community partners

# Mental Health Timeline (individual x)

- June 5<sup>th</sup> – September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 (3 months): 34 calls for service (does not include interactions during foot patrol and continuous collateral calls from public, councillors, other organizations with concerns)
- Total time spent by FPF: approximately 200 hours (estimate)
  - Each call: 1 – 6 officers dispatched
  - Each call: 15 minutes – 7 hoursEstimated costs well over \$10,000 (hours only \$9,142)
- Collaborative plan by mental Health Coordinator
- Calls reduced to 5 calls for service from January 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup> (10 months) in 2018 (requests for stand-by service for planned assistance). Total cost around \$335 (hourly wage\*time)

# Police Time Spent at DECH (2018)

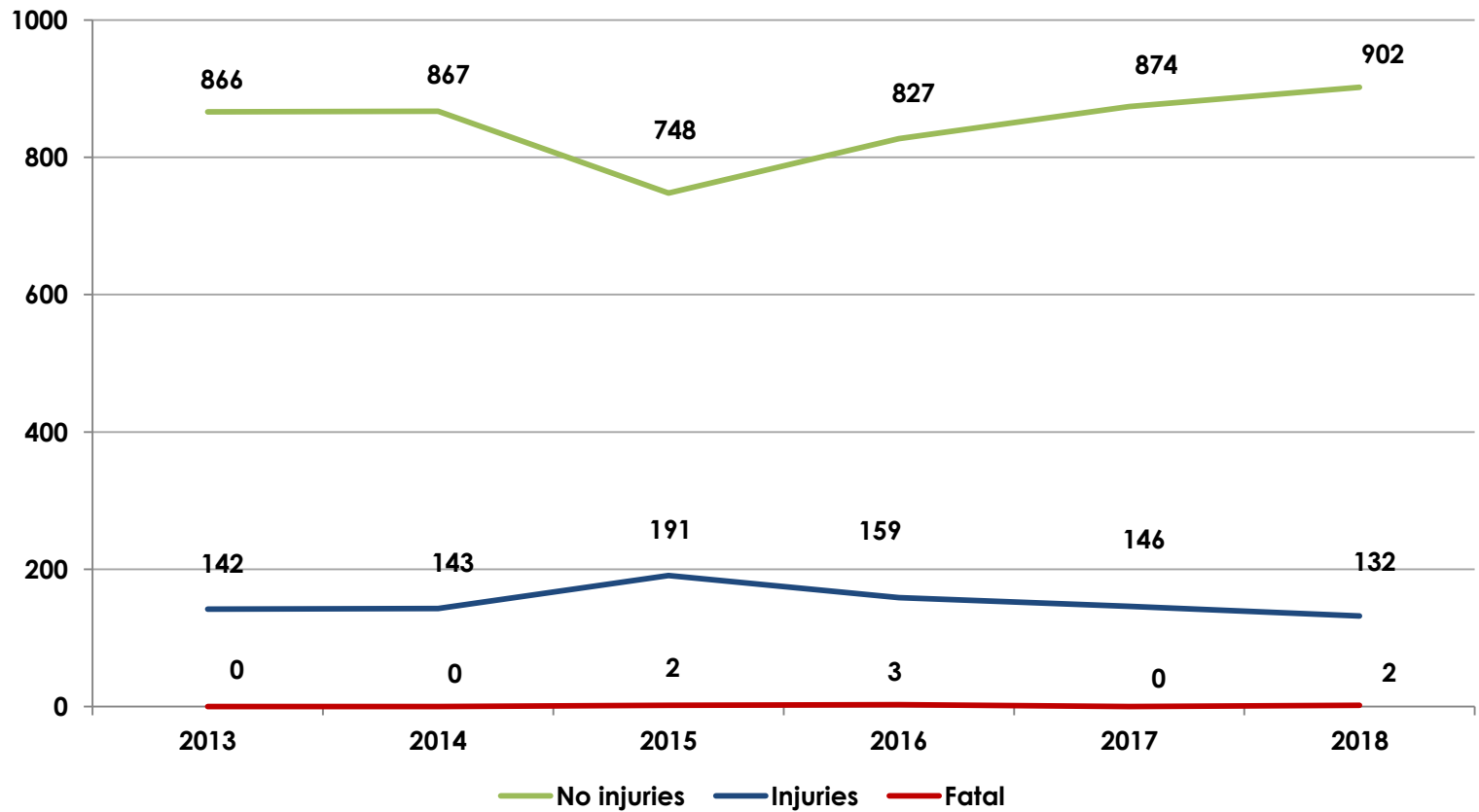
Total Calls for Service (CFS)	235
Total Actual calls for Service (ACFS) (after removing the triage calls and “did not” attend)	181
Total minutes spent at the DECH	21802 minutes (363 hours -22 minutes)
Average time for CFS	1 hour – 32 minutes
Average time spent for ACFS	2 hours – 27 minutes

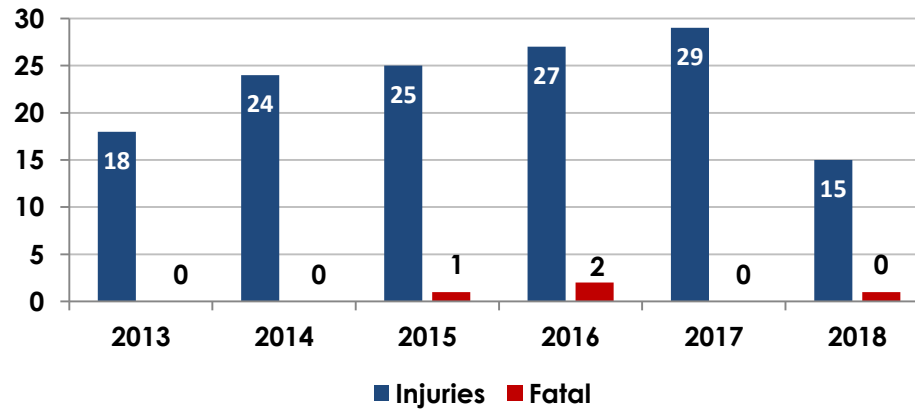

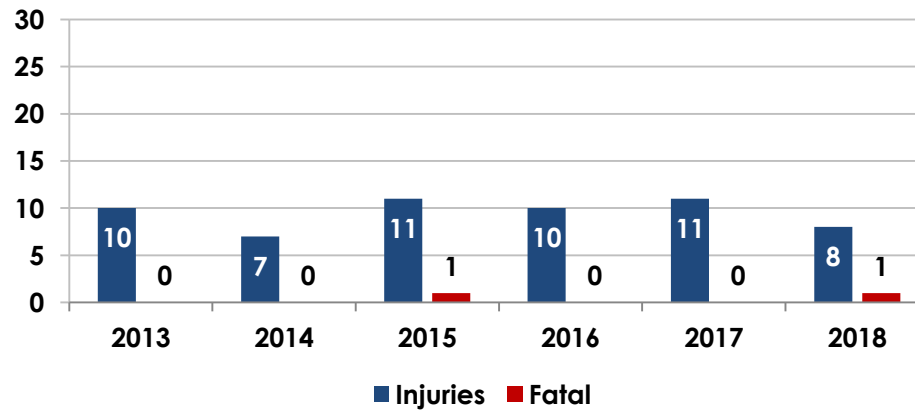
## MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISIONS



## MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISIONS VEHICLE - PEDESTRIAN

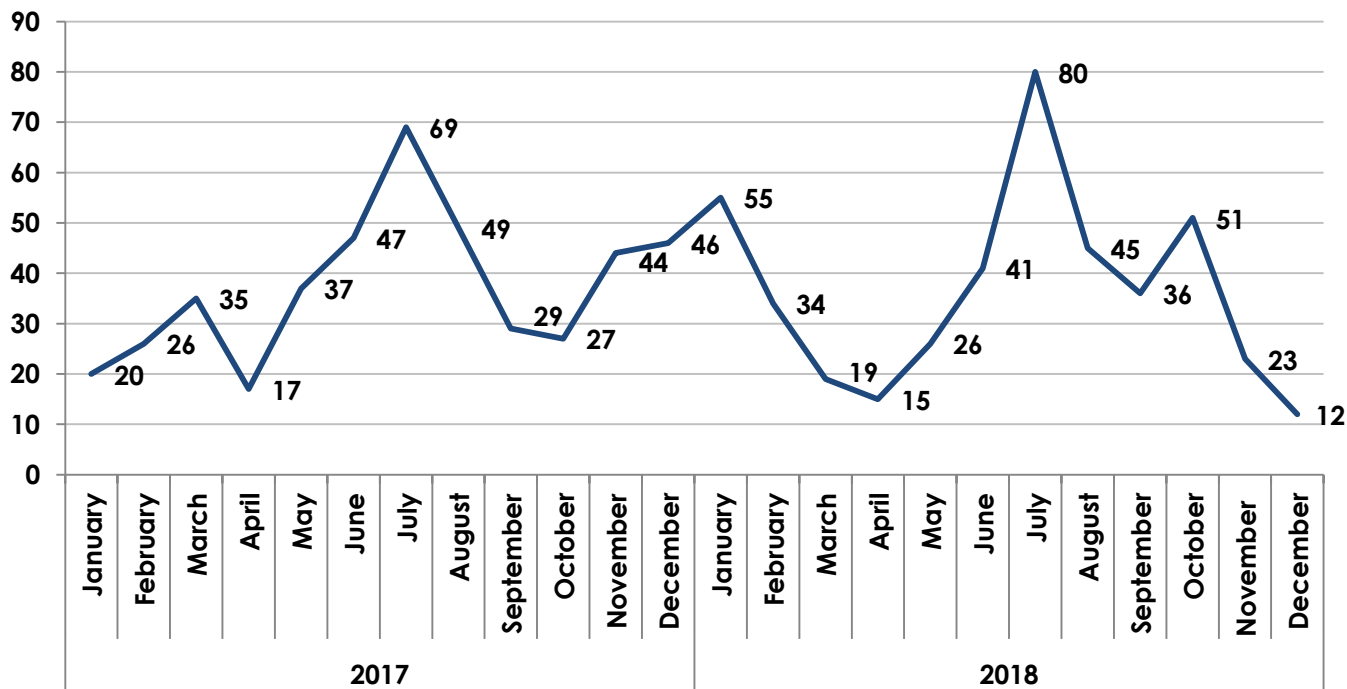


## MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISIONS VEHICLE - CYCLIST

# Criminal Record Checks

- **Vulnerable Sector Checks = 2853**
  - When nature of work, whether paid or volunteer, places the applicant in a position of trust over vulnerable persons, including youth, elderly, mentally or physically challenged
- **Non-vulnerable Sector Checks = 1331**
- **Fingerprints = 147**
