7.7 MILLION m³
of water produced... enough to fill the **SMYTHE STREET WATER TOWER** MORE THAN 3,300 TIMES!

3.8 km of WATER MAIN and 2.9 km of SANITARY SEWER MAIN REPLACED...

ENOUGH TO RUN FROM **Fredericton City Hall** TO THE **Hugh John Flemming Forestry Centre** and back!

ALL WASTEWATER gets treated and returned to the Saint John River.

2023 BUDGET

OPERATING **\$11.9M** CAPITAL **\$11.8M**

By provincial legislation, the Utility is self-funded through rates collected and grants received.

2023 RATES

QUARTERLY SERVICE CHARGE **\$123.80** USAGE RATE **\$1.94/M³**

LOWEST RATES IN THE REGION.
An average family of four pays \$881 a year for water and sewer services.

The Utility is funded separately from the City's general fund, deriving all its revenue from rates charged and funding received from other levels of government.
