- To supervise and ensure the safety of all Zig-Zag participants during program hours
- To receive and take custody of equipment, as well as maintain the Zig-Zag surroundings in a safe, clean and attractive manner
- To aid in the registration process, records of attendance and program implementation, and to attend and actively participate in all training sessions
- To render routine first aid in the case of minor injuries, and to write an accident report on all injuries, which should be given to the Zig-Zag Team leader/ Assistant
- To check the premises for any hazards (i.e. broken equipment, glass, etc....) in the morning and before you leave the park
- To follow designated working hours as indicated, come to work ready to work
- Your first and foremost responsibility is to our program participants
- Respect decisions made by our senior staff
