



APPLICATION FORM – 2021 ARTS, CULTURE & HERITAGE FUNDING PROGRAM

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ!

Due to the pandemic and the likelihood that, for most of 2021, provincial safety guidelines will remain the same as 2020, additional guidelines and criteria will be applied to the 2021 Arts, Culture & Heritage Funding program. This is meant to encourage applications for new projects which will ensure arts and cultural vibrancy in 2021, while also avoiding funds being tied up for projects that have an uncertain capacity for delivery in 2021. Organizations are advised to keep this in mind as applications will be evaluated with these additional criteria.

Additional Guidelines and Criteria for the 2021 Arts, Culture & Heritage Funding program:

- Proposed projects must be permitted to be delivered within the existing restrictions. 'Yellow Phase' restrictions should be kept in mind as a minimum. If you are proposing a project that was canceled in 2020 please clearly demonstrate how the project is better positioned to be delivered in 2021.
- New, innovative projects that engage the community during the current reality while ensuring public safety measures and physical distancing are encouraged.
- Applications for proposed livestream or virtual activities must be able to demonstrate projected participation numbers. If the project was presented virtually in 2020, please provide verified participation numbers and discuss the results in the application.
- Projects proposed in 2021 will be evaluated based on their success in 2020 as indicated in the Final Report.
- Any grants awarded for projects in 2021 which end up being cancelled must be returned to the City.
