## WEDNESDAY WALKERS 2021

A free walking club for all interested adults. This group meets every Wednesday at 10am from early June through to the end of September for a one-hour long walk. Walk routes and meeting/parking sites are listed below.

★ = some steep grades on the trail

1. **August 11 – Nashwaak Trail**- Park on Mill Street (right near the Marysville Bridge over the Nashwaak). We will walk upriver through rural settings with secluded woodland and scenic views of the Nashwaak River.
2. **August 18 - South Riverfront and Salamanca Trails**- You can use the metered parking at the Library or find another downtown spot. We will start from the Library and walk over the overpass, past the lighthouse and the Beaverbrook Museum then proceed along Waterloo Row past Morell Park and onto the short but pretty Salamanca Trail.
3. **August 25 - Killarney Lake (New Trails)** ★ Park at Killarney Lake Rotary Centennial Lodge. We will explore some of the new trails and perhaps finish off with a loop around the lake.
4. **Sept 1 - Northside Trail** - Park at the Trail Visitors Center on Station Rd. We will head generally west along this smooth paved section of trail, through Henry Park toward the Westmorland Street Bridge.
5. **Sept 8 – Lincoln Trail** Park at the picnic shelter on the Lincoln Rd just beyond the intersection with Wilsey Rd. We will head east toward City limits.
6. **Sept 15 - Nashwaak Trail** ★ Drive down River St, in Marysville (Rt side of Nashwaaksis Rvr) 2.7 KM to where Penniac Bridge crosses over top of street. Park on Chase St on right. Walk up path to the NB Trail and onto the Penniac Bridge. Follow out NB Trail 697 m to Chase Xmas Tree Farm.
7. **Sept 22 – Valley Trail**- Park at Angelview Park. We will head east toward Odell Park and the City center. This paved section of trail is a pleasant, flat walk.
8. **Sept 29 –Nashwaak Trail** - Park at the Trail Visitors Center on Station Rd. For this walk we will head up beside Devon Lumber and proceed toward Marysville.
