KEY SUCCESSES



W.L. Barrett Water Treatment Plant was modernized to include a completely upgraded electrical entrance, main disconnect, generator transfer switch, all panels, as well as all interior and exterior lighting.



\$36.4M in funding was announced on June 28, 2022 by the Government of Canada, Province of New Brunswick, and City of Fredericton for two projects focused on rehabilitating water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure within Fredericton. The funding will occur over a five-year period.
